Milwaukee, Wis., 10/16/2004 — The Certification Board of ASQ is pleased to announce that **Brian Joseph Lewis** has completed the requirements to be named an ASQ-Certified Quality Technician, or ASQ CQT.

As such, **Brian Joseph Lewis** has reached a significant level of recognition, indicating a proficiency in and a comprehension of quality principles and practices. Individuals who earn this certification are allowed to use “ASQ CQT” on their business cards and professional correspondence.

“ASQ provides certification as a way to provide formal recognition to professionals who have demonstrated an understanding of, and a commitment to, quality techniques and practices in their job and career,” said Stephen Hacker, ASQ chair. “This is a great accomplishment and, although not a formal registration or licensure, it represents a high level of peer recognition.”

In order to qualify for the Certified Quality Technician examination, an individual must have at least four years of experience related to the Body of Knowledge. The Certified Quality Technician who, in support and under the direction of quality engineers or supervisors, analyzes and solves quality problems, prepares inspection plans and instructions, selects sampling plan applications, trains inspectors and performs audits.

Since 1968, when the first ASQ certification examination was administered, more than 190,000 individuals have taken the path to reaching their goal of becoming ASQ-certified in their field or profession, including many of who have attained more than one designation.
